REUNION FAMILY CARDS

- Show one set of Web Family Cards as your home page
- Show two sets of Web Family Cards tied together with a short web page tying the two sets of cards together.
 - Generate 2 sets of web cards (ancestor, family group)
 - Make a simple web page with a text editor
 - Copy web cards and web page to iDisk
 - Access the web pages

If there is enough time

- **Get Web Site** - How to get a free web site
- **Get FTP Pgm** - How to upload to your free web site

REUNION

Make Web Family Cards your Home Page

- Start Reunion
- Mark one Family
- Create Cards, Destination: iDisk, Home Page
Please note that this will replace your iWeb home page if you have one. If you want to keep the iWeb homepage use the second example which puts the Web Family Cards in their own folder.
- You may also preview your Web Family Cards by creating Web Family Cards, Destination: Safari.

REUNION

Two sets of Web Family Cards in a folder

First we're going to create two sets of Web Family Cards: (a) Ancestors; (b) Family group

To do this, we need to create a folder on our computer to collect all your Web Family Cards. We will later copy them to the iDisk folder, svcgg.

So, create a folder on your desktop called svcgg (or whatever you want to name it), just to speed up the processing. Sending information to the iDisk directly can be slow.

REUNION

1st set of Web Family Cards - **Mark People**

- Go to Home Person (in Reunion)
- Select who will be on the cards by clicking on:
Change | Mark Groups, Then click the following:
People related to | Unmark everybody first | Mark Spouses
- Click "Mark" to mark the relatives and notice that 34 people of (47) are now marked.

REUNION

Web Family Cards - **Create Web Family Cards**

- Click Create | Web Family Cards and click on:
Families with a marked spouse
Web family cards with a person sheet
Sources | Pictures | Web Media Page
- Type in a Title ("Obama Family Line")
- Choose Destination, Web Folder

Create the Card Layouts

I created a layouts called "Everything" for both Web Card and Person sheet layouts with everything checked. It's similar to layouts for charts

REUNION

Web Preferences - Options

- Contact Information
- Cover Page - Choose a graphic of the appropriate size from folder or iPhoto (very important)
- Files - Very important, select:
 - Extension: **“.html”**
 - Cover Page: **“index.html”**
 - Text encoding: Not sure, chose UTF-A(Unicode)
- Footer **“Web Card Demonstration”**
- Index/Surnames:
 - People per index page **“Unlimited”**
 - Check **“Separate web page for surnames”**

REUNION

Web Preferences - Options Continued

- Preferred Picture Size - Use Defaults
- Sources Check "Unlimited", Check "Include multimedia file list", Check "Include multimedia files"
- Web Media Page - Check everything

REUNION

Web Preferences - Style Choices

- Preview Styles by clicking on “Style List”
- Select “Reunion Talk Home” (my favorite) and click on “Apply to All”
- Now, Click “OK”
- Click “Save”
- Select “Desktop”, Folder “svcgg”, and name the Web Family Cards folder, “wfc-relatives”

REUNION

2nd Set of Web Family Cards

For our second set of Web Family Cards it will get a little easier:

- Mark Descendants of Barack Obama (4 people)
- Create Web Family Card, Title "Family Group"
- Choose a Cover Page Graphic
- Choose a Footer - "Obama Family Group"
- Style - Simple09 (light background)
- Click Save
- Select "Desktop", Folder "svcgg", and name the Web Family Cards folder, "wfc-famgroup"

REUNION

Create web page

```

<body>
<h1>Presidential Genealogy Web Cards</h1>
<p align='left'>
<a href='wfc-relatives/index.html'>Relatives</a>

<a href='wfc-famgroup/index.html'>Family Group</a>
</body>
</html>
```

Save as "index.html" in the svcgg folder on desktop.
After, we will copy everything to the iDisk web\sites
folder to a folder names "svcgg"

IDISK

How does iDisk Work?

- Idisk comes with Mobile Me
- It contains a number of folders that can be accessed from the internet, but you can see and use the files on your desktop.
- **Web\Sites** - This folder is special:
It will contain our web site
To access use: <http://web.me.com/user/svcgg/>

IDISK

Copy folder to iDisk web site

- Create another folder in iDisk under the Web/Sites/ folder called "svcgg"
- Copy the files from Desktop\svcgg to the iDisk, Web\Sites\svcgg
- Access the files using the URL
